CLINICAL PRECEPTORSHIP COURSE

Course Overview

The Clinical Preceptorship (CP) Course aims to empower nurses with the requisite knowledge, skills, and attitude for effective clinical supervision for pre-registration or pre-enrolment students.

Nurses are assuming the role of preceptors for student nurses without formal training. With the CP course, it will provide an overview of the wide range of roles and responsibilities of the preceptor and serve as a framework to support the efficient, effective integration and enculturation of students into their respective departments. By preparing and supporting the preceptors in their role of guiding the student nurses, the preceptors will be able to fulfil their responsibility with confidence.

This is an in-house course designed for nurses and enrolled nurses who will have pre-registration or pre-enrolment students under their charge. This course would equip participants with essential knowledge necessary to facilitate clinical teaching, learning and assessment for the students attached to their respective department.

Course Content

- Principles of Preceptorship: Roles & Responsibilities of a Clinical Preceptor
- Adult learning principles and learning styles
- Principles & best practices in clinical supervision and assessment
- Effective communication skills
- Communicating supportive constructive feedback
- Evaluation of clinical education and learning environment

Teaching Methodology

- Blended Learning(Classroom facilitation, discussions, case studies, e-learning and clinical practicum)

Target Audience

- Registered Nurses or Senior Enrolled Nurses/Principal Enrolled Nurse, with a minimum of 2 years' clinical experience and are competent in practice (stipulated in SNB Standards for Clinical Education 2022)
