Programme Overview

This course provides participants with the principles and fundamentals of clinical supervision and assessment of nursing students.

It will provide opportunities for participants to apply theory and best practices in the clinical settings in their role as Clinical Instructors.

Aim

This course aims to equip the participants with the required knowledge and skills to be effective Clinical Instructors in facilitating students to develop their clinical skills, knowledge, and competencies.

Course Structure

- Blended learning approach with web-based learning, tutorial, discussion, role play and simulation based learning and on-the-job training (OJT)
- Theoretical component: 48 hours
Clinical component: 80hours (clinical practicum)
